OVERVIEW

CCA designs, finances, builds, owns and manages prisons, jails and detention facilities on behalf of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the U.S. Marshals Service, nearly half of all states and numerous county agencies. Managing more than half of all beds under contract with corrections management providers, CCA is the fifth-largest corrections system in the United States.

■ VALUE

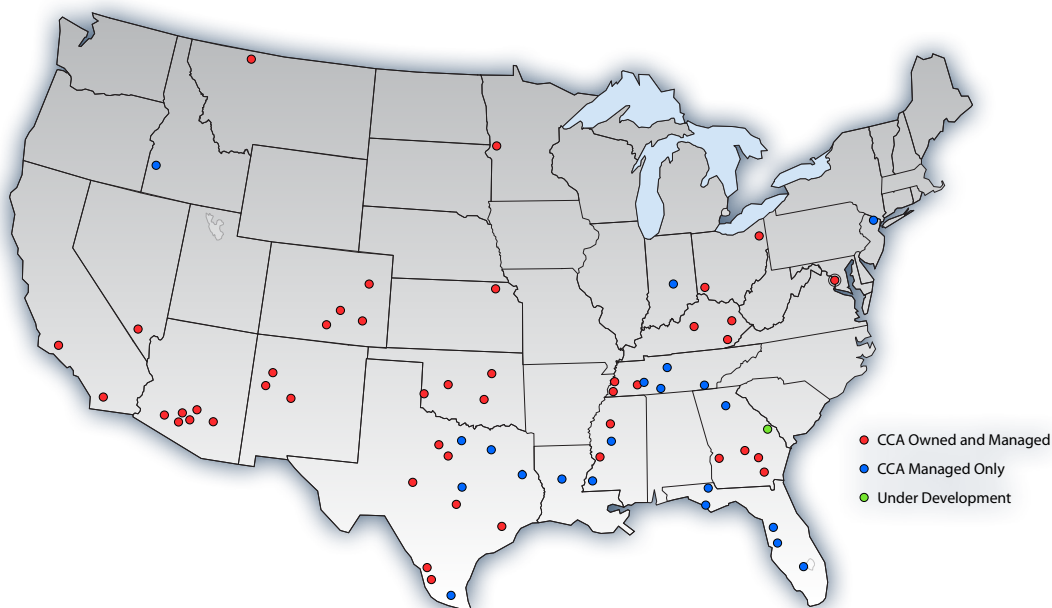
Public-private partnerships enable government to address dangerous prison overcrowding, build new and modern secure facilities and offer rehabilitative opportunities to inmates, backed by an expertly trained workforce of correctional professionals – at less than it costs public agencies to operate.

Plus, CCA facilities typically are less expensive to build than public prisons. They can also be built faster – in 12-18 months compared to 48-60 months in the public sector. These savings can be directed to schools, hospitals and parks, while providing modern and humane treatment for America's prison population.

■ FLEXIBILITY

CCA works with states to arrive at the smartest, safest solutions to reduce overcrowding and address other systemic concerns.

If a state is anticipating a greater need for prison space, but doesn't have the funds to build a new prison, CCA can partner to build a new facility or provide space in an existing CCA facility on an emergency, short-term or long-term basis.
